2023 DIVIDEND – Mr. Sacco reported that the Fund office filed a request for a dividend with Department of Banking and Insurance (DOBI) and the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs (DCA) on October 17, 2023. He advised that on November 22, 2023, the Fund office received correspondence from DOBI recommending the Fund reconsider issuing a dividend due to numerous factors outside the control of the Fund and referred to said correspondence enclosed within the agenda packet. Mr. Sacco reported that the Executive Committee held a summit on November 29, 2023, and discussed DOBI's recommendation. He advised that after careful consideration, the Executive Committee agreed to defer the issuance of a dividend at this time. Mr. Sacco noted that the Executive Committee also resolved to revisit the possibility of issuing a dividend following the 2023 year-end audit of both the Municipal Excess Liability Joint Insurance Fund (MEL) and the Residual Claims Fund (RCF). He referred to Resolution #29-23 reflecting the same and asked if there were any questions. Hearing none, Mr. Sacco asked for a motion to adopt Resolution #29-23.

RESOLUTION NO. 29-23 RESOLUTION OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF THE MONMOUTH MUNICIPAL JOINT INSURANCE FUND AUTHORIZING TO DEFER ITS REQUEST OF REFUND OF CLOSED YEAR ACCOUNTS SURPLUS

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 11:15-2.21 provides that a FUND may seek approval from the Commissioner of Insurance for a refund of excess monies from any FUND year upon compliance with certain requirements; and

WHEREAS, the FUND had obtained a calculation from its Actuary and Executive Director as to the amount of money which is available for distribution consistent with the aforementioned regulations, and the financial integrity of the FUND; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Committee had determined that it would be in the best interest of the FUND and its member municipalities to return a portion of surplus, subject to the approval of the Department of Banking and Insurance (DOBI) and the New jersey Department of Community Affairs (DCA);

WHEREAS, said request was filed on October 17, 2023 with DOBI and NJDCA;

WHEREAS, DOBI wrote to the FUND on November 22, 2023 and recommended against the issuance of a return of surplus due to the potential of additional assessment outside the control of the FUND, the effects of which are unknown at this time;

WHEREAS, The Executive Committee of the FUND met to discuss the concerns raised by DOBI and felt it was in the best interest of the FUND to defer the issuance of a return in surplus;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Executive Committee of the **Monmouth Joint Insurance Fund**, As Follows:

1. Section B of N.J.A.C. 11:15-2.21 provides that the FUND may seek approval for refunds from any claim fund surplus that has been completed for not less than twenty-four months. Based upon this requirement, surplus monies in the Closed Year Accounts are eligible for refunds at the discretion of the FUND, the Department of Banking and Insurance and the Department of Community Affairs.

2. The FUND will re-evaluate its financial position after the 2023 year-end Financials are calculated for the FUND as well as the Residual Claims Fund Joint Insurance Fund (RCF) and the Municipal Excess Liability Joint Insurance Fund (MEL).

3. The FUND will take into consideration any additional assessment levied by the RCF and/ or the MEL.

4. After that evaluation, the FUND may then seek to reinstate a request for a dividend to be issued.

5. The Executive Director's office Chief Accounting Officer is authorized to reflect the Financial effects of this Resolution in the books and records of the FUND and notify and coordinate the same with the FUND's auditor.
